In 1950 my brother Jim and I, together with fellow St. Agnes Alumni David and Louis Kee (also brothers) and Francis Boyle were all at Camp Lejeune for Advanced Combat Training, recalled for the Korean War. We all served in Korea, but I never saw either of the Kee's or Boyle *until* David came up from Pensacola, FL for *this* reunion. He served in the Corps for 30 years! His brother David served for 20, and I put in 22. So this was a *56-year reunion!*
